# GIN

## Prices per 25ml measure

Our gin list has been chosen with love, care and a lot of hard work - tasting! We are great fans of the ultimate gin encyclopaedia, Diffordsguide Gin: The Bartenders Bible, and so, where applicable, show his rating of certain high scoring gins. That doesn't mean the other ones are less superior but a 5 Star rating from Difford's is big news!

### **6 O'clock (43%)**

**£3.20**

Made with just 7 botanicals, including Elderflower, orange peel, Juniper, Coriander, Orris, and Angelica it has an ABV of 43%. It's smooth and fresh in almost a traditional London dry style, however the orange peel adds a delightful citrusiness to the gin gently balanced by the floral scents of the Elderflower. The result is a clean, smooth, richly flavoured gin.

### **Adnams, First Rate (48%)**

**£4.20**

Made with a complex and powerful blend of 13 botanicals to complement the strength of this spirit, it delivers aromatic spices mingled with Juniper and softened with hints of citrus.

### **Batch, Burnley (40%)**

**£3.20**

Burnley Gin - whatever next! Fresh bursts of juniper greet your tongue, followed by a mix of spices that seem to wrap their arms around your senses and create a wonderful symphony of flavours. Amongst these is a tangy liquorice offset with some subtle background notes of clove. A mild, sweet almost floral, element comes through, but this sits on top of an earthiness that acts as a great undertone to the total sum of flavours. Sweet baby Jesus! Frankincense and Myrrh?

### **Bathtub (45%)**

**£3.20**

The term *bathtub gin* was used to describe the home made gin in prohibition times, it often conjures up glamorous images of flapper girls, speakeasies and the Roaring Twenties. An extraordinary award-winning gin, produced by the enigmatic Professor Cornelius Ampleforth. Made using the traditional method of Cold Compounding (or in layman's terms - infusing). The result is an extraordinary gin, lightly tinted by the botanicals, and with a flavour which is both bold and perfumed, all at once.

### **Beefeater 24 (45%)**

**£3.20**

12 botanicals steeped for 24 hours - hence the name. Aside from the magnificent bottle, which has heritage clues and hidden symbols all the way through it, its juniper, pine and refreshingly clean nature got this a Difford's 5 Star Excellent Rating.

### **Beefeater, Burrough's Reserve (43%)**

**£10.00**

Beefeater Burrough's Reserve Edition is a testament to the fact that doing things differently can create an exceptional outcome. It's a drink for those who are looking for something new, rare and hard to find. It emerges with a copper hue and complex depth of flavour. Each batch created is unique. They only create a limited number of bottles for release, ensuring that each drop of gin has the time, care and attention to detail that a spirit this remarkable deserves.

### **Bertha's Revenge, Irish Milk (42%)**

**£4.20**

A gin from Ballyvolane House named after Bertha, a Droimeann cow from Kerry said to have been the oldest in the world when she died aged 48 in 1993. The gin uses whey alcohol from Irish dairies as its base with locally foraged botanicals. The botanicals include juniper, coriander, bitter orange, grapefruit, sweet orange, lemon, lime, liquorice, orris, angelica, cinnamon, cardamom, cloves, cumin, almond, elderflower, and sweet woodruff.

### **Big Boss, Portugal (40%)**

**£4.20**

Fresh and bold, Big Boss Gin, is a unique and outstanding Portuguese gin. Taking a secret formula of 11 botanicals and using traditional Portuguese techniques to distil 4 times, Big Boss is an audacious and distinct spirit. Cardamom and angelica come through clearly, backed by a warm earthiness. Refreshing and smooth, Big Boss is a fantastic gin.

### **Bimber (42%)**

**£3.20**

Distilled in a traditional copper still pot, Bimber Distillery's London Dry Gin is created from an old, original recipe using carefully selected botanicals for a unique, distinctive taste. Full of flavour with a refreshing citrus character, experience the power and passion of Bimber Distillery's London Dry Gin.

### **Blackwoods, Shetland (40%)**

**£3.20**

Blackwood's are the only producer to state a vintage on their bottle. This is because all the botanicals used in the production are sourced from the Shetland Isles and are therefore at the mercy of the elements. Their Gin varies slightly from year to year depending on the availability of the various botanicals. A crisp and richly aromatic gin, its Nordic recipe reflects its Viking origins, offering just a hint of sea in its taste, ideal for a gin and tonic.

### **Black Tomato (42.3%)**

**£5.00**

Black Tomato Gin is produced by Kampen Distillery in the Netherlands, nestled in the small fishing town of Bruinisse. The signature black tomatoes are grown near the distillery and they even go so far as to add a splash of local seawater to the mixture. Black Tomato Gin is a robust and powerful spirit with lots of different flavours at play. Rich dark fruits are obvious and followed by pleasant spices on the palate.

### **Bloom (40%)**

**£3.20**

A beautifully, fragrant, citric, elegant and perfumed gin with less of a dominance from juniper and more on the aromatics of chamomile, honeysuckle and orange, this is a great introduction to gin. Perfect with Fever Tree Elderflower tonic and strawberries!

### **Bobby's, Schiedam Dry (42%)**

**£3.20**

Bobby's Schiedam Dry Gin is named after Jacobus Alfons, known to his friends and family as Bob or Bobby. They have created unique gin, blending the tradition of Schiedam jenever with the best Indonesian botanicals and spices. It is a very fine and balanced distilled gin with eight botanicals all separately distilled. No additives, sugars or extractions, simply pure taste and a fresh take on a timeless classic. Malt wine based, juniper, lemongrass, cardamom and cubeb pepper.

### **Bombay Sapphire (40%)**

**£3.20**

The taste of Bombay Sapphire is created through the vapour infusion process, this infusion mixed with the Tuscan juniper berries brings about a beautifully dry and fragrant, herbal aroma and taste. Other botanicals include; lemon peel and grains of paradise giving a beautiful exotic edge.

### **Botanic, Kiss (37.5%)**

**£3.20**

Botanic Kiss Gin is made in Spain using triple-distilled English grain. It is a blend of classic botanicals: juniper berries, coriander seeds, angelica root, orange peel, lemon peel, orris root, liquorice root, cassia, almond shells, sweet orange and Buddha's hand, with strawberries, raspberries and cranberries. The latter add a natural pink colour and lots of fruitiness.

### **Brighton (40%)**

**£4.20**

Clear and bright in the glass, the subtle notes of juniper come forward as you swirl, releasing sweet-scented fresh citrus and a touch of spice. The persistent hints of orange make this gin gentle and approachable.

### **Broken Heart (40%)**

**£3.20**

Broken Heart gin of New Zealand has an intricate balance of 11 herbs and has made sure that their juniper presence is strong. Angelica root, plus Nelson grown hops and malt, give this gin a robust, wholesome and earthy character.

### **Brockman's, Blackberry and Blueberry infused (40%)**

**£3.20**

This is distinctly different from the traditional London Dry style. Marrying up beautifully, the blueberries and blackberries are an inspired combination and together with the dry, bitter sweet Valencia oranges make Brockman's a beautiful, intensely smooth gin. Try with Fever Tree Ginger ale for something completely different.

### **Brontë, A Yorkshire Lass' (40%)**

**£3.20**

Samantha Long, founder of the Spirits of Bronte Drinks Company, is a 'Yorkshire lass' who has lived in Bronte Country for over 30 years. As a lover of small batch gins, she was inspired by the rugged landscape and literary heritage of her local area to create an old-school drink that tasted like when 'gin was gin'. On the nose it is citrus with high notes of juniper, with a perfect balance of sour from lemon & orange vs sweet from liquorice & cassia bark on the palate.

### **Bulldog (40%)**

**£3.20**

The gin lover will enjoy this enlightening experience, which begins with a full bouquet of floral and citrus fragrances that tantalize the senses and invite one to guess their sources. The initial introduction of flavours is one of subtle juniper that leads into a crisp harmony of countless botanicals. With each sip, new notes can be found with lavender, citrus and juniper dominating. A short, warm, floral finish is a fine finale for the Bulldog Gin journey.

### **Buss No 509, Elderflower (40%)**

**£4.20**

An elderflower variant of Buss No.509 Gin! A prickle of woody juniper and creamy angelica, up front, soon joined by light, sweet elderflower wafting in from all angles.

### **Caorunn, Small Batch Scottish (41.8%)**

**£3.20**

Caorunn, pronounced 'Ka-roon', harnesses Scotland's unique natural resources and age-old botanicals. It is made using eleven infused botanicals in a unique copper berry chamber still. The word Carunn is a Gaelic word for Rowan Berry that has been the inspiration of medicines and recipes for generations.

### **Citadelle (44%)**

**£3.20**

Citadelle Gin has a delicate and fragrant nose of fresh flowers, jasmine, honeysuckle and cinnamon. After a few moments, stronger, more herbaceous aromas of anise, grains of paradise and cinnamon develop in a most remarkable way. The appetizing bouquet is reminiscent of gardens in springtime. On the palate, juniper gives way to a voluptuous complexity redolent of fresh flowers, leading into an elegant, round and highly refined finish.

### **Cruxland, South Africa (43%)**

**£3.20**

KWV wanted to create a special gin with botanicals typical to South Africa and knew they needed a special ingredient to complement the flavours of the other botanicals... Kalahari truffles only grow in the Kalahari after the first rain. Cruxland gin has a bold and earthy character, some of the botanicals include; juniper berries, honey bush tea, coriander, rooibos, aniseed, cardamom, almonds, and lemon.

### **Cuckoo (43%)**

**£4.20**

Cuckoo Gin is made with ingredients that are locally sourced and grown on their farm in Lancashire. After a slightly sweet, piney juniper start, the flavour develops into citrus from orange, grapefruit and lemon with a lingering taste of cinnamon spice and liquorice. Dry on the finish with a peppery kick coming from coriander seeds.

### **Curio (41%)**

**£4.20**

The newest Cornish Gin to join the market is Curio Rock Samphire Gin. Two years in the making it is a quadruple distilled gin with a lovely fresh nose of juniper, cinnamon and a slight hint of salt spray. Made with hand foraged Rock Samphire from the local cliff edges and a selection of others botanicals. Delicate and smooth to taste it is spicy on the palate with balanced botanicals. Enjoy as a classic G&T or on its own with ice.

### **Da Mhile, Seaweed (42%)**

**£4.20**

This seaweed gin is made with a cut-down, hand selected variant of botanicals added to a small batch gin. Designed to complement seafood it is infused with handpicked seaweed from the Celtic coast for three weeks, giving it a lovely light green hue before being triple filtered and bottled.

### **Daffy's (43.4%)**

**£3.20**

Named after the goddess of Gin and sporting her likeness on the bottle, Daffy's utilise Lebanese mint which they balance with eight other carefully chosen botanicals, Daffy's have created an exceptionally fresh, smooth and truly original gin with complexity and balance.

## GIN CONTINUED....

### **Darnley View, Spiced (42.7%)**

**£3.20**

Darnley view spiced gin, is made using the same distillation process as the original Darnley view gin. The neutral grain spirit is 4 times distilled, and the gin is a classic London dry gin style. In order to create the spice they have added cinnamon to create peppery bite and nutmeg to add subtle eastern spice, the combination alongside the juniper is divine.

### **Death's Door, U.S.A (47%)**

**£4.20**

From the tiny Washington Island in Lake Michigan, using just three botanicals, organic juniper berries, coriander and fennel, Death's Door has an intriguingly complex profile with notes of cream soda, anise and citrus. Difford's 5 star Outstanding Rating.

### **Dingle (42.5%)**

**£3.20**

An artisan, pot still, hand crafted Gin, produced by The Dingle Whiskey Distillery based in County Kerry, Ireland. The flavours and botanicals in Dingle Original Gin include rowan berry, fuchsia, bog myrtle, hawthorn, heather, chervil, angelica and coriander - locally grown botanicals giving that 'taste of Kerry'.

### **Edgerton, Original Pink (47%)**

**£3.20**

This contains no less than 15 botanicals in its recipe. Original Pink has crisp citrus top notes, with a smooth delicately spicy development thanks to Grains of Paradise. It owes its blush to pomegranate, and a hint of mint comes from Damiana V the invigorating plant of Mexico. For all its originality, Edgerton is reassuringly & unmistakably in the tradition of great London dry gins.

### **Eden Mill (42%)**

**£3.20**

Eden Mill Original Gin is the St Andrews take on a classic London Dry. Made from Fife's sea buckthorn berries, which is a super food that happens to grow within walking distance from their St Andrews distillery. The unique tart berry flavour is abundant but is well balanced by using citrus such as lemon balm and citrus peel. This gin is on quite a different level to most.

### **Few, Barrel Aged (46.5%)**

**£4.20**

What was once clear, is now complex. Exuding subtle notes of fennel & peppery spices, while a smokey smoothness from the charred barrel permeates the juniper, this barrel-aged spirit tastes like gin, but has the maturity of a Bourbon Whiskey.

## GIN CONTINUED....

### **Forest (42%)**

**£4.20**

The epitome of small batch gin, Forest is infused with hand foraged bilberries, raspberries and blackberries, creating a wonderfully fruity gin with great balance. With the addition of more familiar coriander, vanilla, liquorice root, angelica and of course juniper a truly spectacular gin is born. The bottle is hand made Porcelain and sports a very unique decorative pattern.

### **Faith & Sons (42.2%)**

**£3.20**

Handcrafted in Manchester using just 6 organic botanicals from around the world - Juniper from Croatia, Coriander from Austria, Angelica from Poland, Liquorice Root from China, Lemon Verbena from Paraguay and Mandarin Peel from South Africa. This creates a very smooth fresh experience. With aromas of green hints of truffles.

### **Gin Mare (42.7%)**

**£4.20**

An interesting "Mediterranean" styled gin that pushes the boundaries with its flavour profile. Rosemary, thyme, olive and basil harvested near the fishing village of Costa Dorada in Spain are used alongside the more traditional botanicals. All the botanicals except the citrus, are macerated individually and then brought together at the last minute. The rosemary stands out, but the juniper is there as well and everything seems to work together. Drink with Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic as the perfect mixer.

### **Ginger Ninja (42%)**

**£3.20**

On the nose the juniper, angelica and liquorice come through, with the ginger also standing out. On the palette it is initially powered by the juniper, followed by a subtle mix of the more unusual botanicals, before the ginger really comes through to give a long and warm, lingering finish.

### **Gunpowder, Drumshanbo, Irish (43%)**

**£5.00**

Drumshanbo Gunpowder Irish Gin is an oriental-inspired spirit from The Shed Distillery in Co Leitrim. Taking its name from one of the signature botanicals, slowly dried Gunpowder Tea, the recipe also includes lime, lemon and grapefruit.

### **Garden Tiger (47%)**

**£4.20**

Using an incredible mix of 34 carefully chosen botanicals, Garden Tiger Gin is floral yet fruity with fabulous woody, pine notes at the fore. A very modern gin made by combining two traditions (the production of eau de vie and of gin), blood orange and mulberry have a prominent place while pear, lime and gentle spice linger in the background.



## GIN CONTINUED....

### **G'Vine, Floraison, France (40%)**

**£3.20**

Produced in the French region of Cognac, G'Vine is a hint as to what this unique gin contains. It's actually infused with Ugni Blanc grape, as well as some more standard botanicals including ginger root, liquorice, cardamom, cassia bark, coriander, cubeb berries, nutmeg, lime and even a bit of juniper.

### **G'Vine, Nouaison, France (43.9%)**

**£3.20**

A higher-strength limited-edition variant from G'Vine, whose standard bottling is also extremely classy gin. Nouaison is batch-distilled in a copper pot still and flavoured with fresh botanicals, including the grape flower. 5 Star Excellent Difford's rating.

### **Harrogate, Otterly Marvellous! (43%)**

**£4.20**

All of Harrogate Tipple's spirits are made using 100% Harrogate Spring Water. The botanicals for their gin are sourced locally from Harlow Carr, the Royal Horticultural Society's garden in Harrogate. Tom Nichol, their expert Master Distiller, with over 42 years of experience and a love of Harrogate, has created this Otterly Marvellous Tipple. You will immediately taste the characteristic sweetness of the pink grapefruit blended with a delicate hint of Yorkshire lavender - crisp, yet gentle on the palette.

### **Hendricks (41.4%)**

**£3.20**

Its botanical signature consists of flowers, roots, fruits and seeds from all over the world, setting the stage for the infusion of Bulgarian Rosa Damascena and specially selected cucumbers. This is the coming together of two different spirits from two rare and unusual stills, the combination creating an extraordinarily smooth gin with unique character and balance of subtle flavours.

### **Hepple (45%)**

**£4.20**

Hepple includes green juniper, douglas fir, blackcurrant leaves and bog myrtle. On the nose there is an immediate fresh scent of green apple, bright grapefruit and spicy juniper. This then opens up to reveal underlying notes of douglas fir, and fragrant blackcurrant. On sipping, the initial fresh citrus flavours evolve into unexpected ripe cantaloupe melon. The spicy fragrant juniper continues to coat the palate. There is a luscious sweet mouthfeel, which is both juicy and quenching. The finish is extremely long and this is where the juniper reveals itself further!

### **Hoxton (40%)**

**£4.20**

Hoxton believe that quality is key, so they only used a medley of natural and ethically sourced botanicals to create their gin. Their botanicals include; coconut, grapefruit, juniper, iris, tarragon and Ginger. These are macerated for 5 days before a single distillation in 150 year old copper pot stills. There is a subtle rather than overwhelming presence of juniper on the nose; on the palate there is coconut and grapefruit, with grapefruit winning out in the end.

## GIN CONTINUED....

### **Hedgehog (43%)**

**£4.20**

Hedgehog Gin was launched in 2016 and is the creation of Finnish spirits company 'One Eyed Spirits' who were first known for producing Ron de Jeremy Rum – named after America's iconic star of adult cinema, Ron Jeremy. Nicknamed 'The Hedgehog', Ron Jeremy is also the inspiration behind their gin which includes botanicals such as ginseng, damiana, guarana and bergamot, described as 'Love Herbs' on the bottle.

### **Ish (41%)**

**£3.20**

Modern-ish returns to a traditional London Dry style of gin, but with-a-twist: an extra shot of juniper. A perfectly balanced recipe that provides a distinctive taste profile without any added infusions or flavours.

### **Jensens, Bermondsey Dry (43%)**

**£3.20**

Bermondsey Dry is a recreation of a lost style of London Dry gin. Designed to emulate the gins of the early 20th century. Less juniper centric, it shines a light on the full spectrum of classic gin botanicals, making it the quintessential gin for the classic dry martini. Clean, dry palate with pine fresh juniper to the fore with coriander and strong hints of parma violet from the orris. Licorice and nutty almond notes on the finish. 5 Star Outstanding Difford's Rating

### **Jensens, Old Tom (43%)**

**£3.20**

Unsweetened and earthy, it has a deep flavour that adds complexity to many drinks. Classic gin botanicals only, with a focus on the roots and spices. The botanicals are added to the still, dried and then steeped to release their flavour. On the nose there is a huge root hit, ample musk and spice. Apparent sweetness on nose yet the palette is dry. Concentrated flavour tightly wound, however it opens up hugely when mixed.

### **Ki No Bi (47.5%)**

**£4.20**

Produced at Japan's Kyoto Distillery, Ki No Bi is the first gin to be made in the city. Made with a rice spirit and botanicals including yellow yuzu, Japanese cypress, green tea, bamboo and sanso berries (Japanese peppercorn), this has classic juniper notes which complement the Japanese botanicals.

### **Larios, Rose (37.5%)**

**£3.20**

A gin with strawberry flavour and aroma. Larios rose fuses Mediterranean citrus with its main ingredient, strawberries.

## GIN CONTINUED....

### **Little Bird (41.6%)**

**£4.20**

Little Bird is made using 10 carefully selected botanicals distilled in London in small batches by a master distiller. The result is a well-rounded, citrus-forward London Dry Gin that goes just splendidly in a classic G&T. A dynamic nose, bustling with grapefruit is followed by a fresh palate of juniper and further citrus, complimented by spicy ginger and coriander.

### **Liverpool, Valencian Orange (47%)**

**£3.20**

Liverpool Distillery's head distiller created Liverpool Gin Valencian Orange as homage to his new daughter-in-law's home, in Spain. Sweet Valencia orange dominates, with crystallized ginger and candied citrus but this is pleasantly balanced by a peppery juniper and herbaceous coriander.

### **Sir Robin of Locksley (40.5%)**

**£3.20**

In a nod to their geographical location, it is named in honour of a favourite Yorkshire lad and local Sheffield legend, Robin Hood. It has up-front juniper with more delicate aromas of elderflower bubbling through. Deliciously smooth and round on the palate – warm cassia notes are soothed with dandelion. Pink grapefruit adds an underlying sweetness and lingering citrus finish.

### **Malfy (41%)**

**£3.20**

Tasted neat, the lemon is overwhelming and bordering on a sherberty limoncello. With the addition of a mixer the core gin botanicals (juniper, coriander seed) come back into contention. Malfy Gin is always going to be a lemon forward gin – Con Limone – kind of gives that away... but there is a gin under there and while progressive, it still appeals to any classic gin fans. The finish has a lovely depth too, with more piney wood-floor notes coming through.

### **Martin Millers, Reformed (40%)**

**£3.20**

The aroma from the gin, is gentle and fresh; a scent that carries soft juniper, citrus and a sweet spiciness. The smell of alcohol is a very faint undercurrent. The gin follows through where the aroma left-off. It has a sweet, creamy, silky mouth-feel. This then resolves into a wash of citrus flavours, finally trailing-off in a long, warm, spicy finish. The mouth keeps on tingling with citrus, long after the spice has faded. The juniper is soft and understated, being in balance with the other flavours, rather than dominating.

### **Mary-le-bone (50.2%)**

**£4.20**

A classic London dry gin produced in London and sold primarily in the Marylebone district. A delicate and complex gin, bursting with floral overtones, with a strong juniper, sweet citrus and grapefruit taste leading into more intense floral and citrus notes. A beautiful warming finish with notes of cassia, cloves and liquorice.

### **Masons, Yorkshire (42%)**

**£3.20**

Small batch gin from Ripon, North Yorkshire. Using Harrogate Spring Water and a perfect balance of juniper, they even have their own Juniper bushes, citrus and other secret botanicals, this is not your run of the mill gin. Spicy, slightly malty with hints of fennel, juniper and pine! Great stuff.

### **Masons, Lavender Edition (42%)**

**£3.20**

The award winning Masons Yorkshire gin has released a wonderful lavender edition. Unveiled in mid-2015, this is a Masons Dry Yorkshire Gin with a focus on the intense, fragrant and subtly sweet notes of lavender.

### **Masons, Tea Edition (42%)**

**£3.20**

Not only have Masons created an award winning Gin they have branched out and created a Yorkshire tea edition as well, they are certainly keeping it close to the Yorkshire spirit! It has a wonderful essence of tea on the nose, there are sweet notes and an element of citrus. There is a wonderful tang when it hits your palate, soft and subtle flavours then follow. Definitely worth a try.

### **Mombassa Club, Dry (41.5%)**

**£4.20**

Mombassa Club London Dry Gin takes its name from a private social club founded in 1885, who imported gin from England to the island of Zanzibar for their members to enjoy. Mombassa Club London Dry Gin is made four times distilled and features a botanical selection that includes juniper, cassia bark, angelica root, coriander seed, clove and cumin, resulting in a bold, spicy flavour profile.

### **Mombassa Club, Strawberry (37.5%)**

**£4.20**

Mombassa Club Strawberry Edition is a more fruitful edition which is infused with strawberries after being triple distilled. It has a delicate pink colour with rich aromas of strawberries on the nose, and the flavours balance between sweetness and acidity with bold fruity notes

### **MOM, God Save the Gin (47%)**

**£4.20**

MOM, The Queen of Gins, was created with the aim of breaking stereotypes. Smooth but distinctive, aristocratic and plebeian, elegant and rebellious. Its design, black and magenta, is intended to represent the duality of the British character: tradition and modernity. The result is a premium gin made with red berries and exotic botanicals that blend into an extremely gentle drink. Its exciting personality results from infusing the gin with red berries after four distillations in copper stills.

## GIN CONTINUED....

### **Monkey 47, Black Forest, Germany (47%)**

**£5.00**

This German Gin from the Black Forest is made using a whopping 47 botanicals. At least a 3rd of these are locally sourced, with others coming from as far as East Asia. Monkey 47's pièce de résistance is the use of local cranberries as some-what of a "secret weapon".

### **Nordes (40%)**

**£3.20**

Nordés Atlantic Galician Gin is a rather intriguing Spanish gin made with an Albariño-grape-based spirit, rather than your more commonly seen grain-based spirit, along with 12 botanicals including lemon peels, hibiscus, liquorice and eucalyptus. The result is a bold, floral flavour profile that would befit summer drinks and cocktails. The bottle is quite stylish too - very impressive stuff!

### **Ophir, Spiced (40%)**

**£3.20**

Casting your mind back to the opening of the spice route by the Portuguese, and then the mighty Dutch East India Company trading spices that their flotilla of vehicles brought back from the East. This pays homage to that: a London Dry Gin infused with more flavours of the Orient than normal.

### **Pinkster (37.5%)**

**£3.20**

Pinkster is deliciously dry, with a hint of raspberry and is exquisitely smooth as it is triple distilled. Raspberries are also infused in the gin after distillation, which is why the liquid has a pink hue. Whilst it is purposefully different to most gins, a healthy dose of juniper ensures that the gently prevalent raspberry scent is accompanied by that customary dryness.

### **Poetic License, Northern Dry (40%)**

**£3.20**

Poetic License Northern Dry Gin is a citrusy yet spicy gin from a small batch distillery. Northern Dry begins with sweetness and ends on a slightly peppery eucalyptus finish. Perfectly clear and delightfully unusual.

### **Poetic License, Picnic, Strawberries & Cream (40%)**

**£3.20**

A summery release from Sunderland's Poetic License Distillery, Picnic Gin is distilled, as well as infused, with strawberries. This results in a creamy texture with lots of red-fruit notes as well as hints of juniper, coriander and orris root. This works particularly as a summer cup with lemonade, fresh fruit and a sprig of mint.

### **Pollination (42%)**

**£4.20**

Pollination has 29 botanicals, 20 of which are wild foraged in the only UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve in Wales. Pollination Gin combines rich pine, green herb and lifted floral flavours, which lead to a honeyed flavour on a complex palate.

### **Poppies, Rubbens (40%)**

**£4.20**

The Rubbens Gin Distillery was founded in 1817 in East Flanders, the birthplace of gin. The company is still in family hands and is proud to utilize traditional techniques and recipes to create their fine and flavoursome gins and liqueurs. Poppies is an exceptionally aromatic gin, full of flavoursome herbs and pine, the gins' Belgian roots are evident.

### **Rock Rose, Scottish (41.5%)**

**£3.20**

Rock Rose Gin is made at the Dunnet Bay Distillery all the way up in Caithness, Scotland. On the nose, Rock Rose has a delicate bouquet of rose, mixed with deeper cardamom and a touch of citrus are all fused into a mouth-watering mix. Fruity berries merge with the floral nose to give a full-bodied, rounded flavour.

### **Sacred, Pink Grapefruit (43.8%)**

**£3.20**

From the Sacred Craft Distillery in Highgate, comes the Pink Grapefruit Gin, made using every bit of the grapefruit, from the flesh to the peel and even the pips! It may sound obvious, but by golly does this have some phenomenal pink grapefruit flavours.

### **Sharish Blue Magic (40%)**

**£5.00**

In Sharish Blue Magic you will find strawberry, fresh raspberries, cinnamon, cardamom, lemon, angelica root, ginger, liquorice, coriander seed and juniper. A flower by the name Clitoria Ternatea provides the gin with its blue hue without the need of any artificial colouring. The Magic happens when tonic water is added, it transforms it from a blue gin to a vibrant pink gin.

### **Sheep's Eye (42%)**

**£3.20**

Sheep's Eye Gin is a natural blend of 10 botanicals, carefully selected to complement each other. Using flavours such as celery seed, black pepper and thyme, this gin is a unique blend giving a crisp flavour. On the nose it is soft and slightly floral, with the juniper tones coming through. On the pallet, the traditional gin flavours come through first, with a strong juniper start, followed hints of pepper, celery and thyme coming through on the finish.

### **Sikkim, Bilberry (40%)**

**£4.20**

Prepared with a base of red tea made in the Tibetan region of Sikkim, a part of India famous for some of the best teas in the world. Using copper stills made in 1831 and an ideal distillation method with the perfect balance in the proportions of alcohol and essences, they make an exciting range of gins. Sikkim Bilberry provides a sweet fruity taste on the palate with the aroma of flowers.

### **Sikkim, Fraise (40%)**

**£4.20**

Sikkim Fraise is full of juniper and summer berries. A gentle pine flavour combined with red tea, floral essences, strawberries of the forest and red cranberries. The coriander raises its head alongside a touch of bitter orange

### **Silent Pool (43%)**

**£3.20**

Silent Pool Gin is a classic gin at heart. It is full-bodied and fresh, with depth, clarity, and above all else flavour. Produced with 24 unique botanicals, Silent Pool is a rich and clean juniper-driven spirit with floral layers of lavender and chamomile. Fresh notes of citrus and kafir lime are grounded with the subtle sweetness of local honey, creating a well-balanced gin that is both traditional and refreshingly individual.

### **Sipsmith, V.J.O.P (57.7%)**

**£4.20**

VJOP – Very Juniper Over-Proof of course! It says it all – the Sipsmith guys know how to make gin. On the nose junipery pine and cedar wood dominate with hints of zesty orange. BIG juniper upfront on the palate with rich spice and notes of dark chocolate. A long and dry finish with a lovely balance as the juniper shines through.

### **Slingsby, Harrogate (42%)**

**£3.20**

Produced using botanicals sourced locally to Harrogate and made with water from the famous Harrogate aquifer. There's an initial burst of refreshing rhubarb and citrus from the grapefruit base which gives way to juniper before a very smooth herbaceous sweetness.

### **Slingsby, Rhubarb Edition (40%)**

**£3.20**

A limited edition rhubarb flavoured gin from Yorkshire made with locally sourced botanicals and Harrogate aquifer water. Initial sweetness of rhubarb and raspberry followed by the bitter tang of the pink grapefruit citrus base. A tart rhubarb finish rounds off the drink leaving an unforgettable flavour on the palate.

### **Star of Bombay (47.5%)**

**£4.20**

Featuring two unique additional botanicals – Bergamot orange peel from Calabria in southern Italy and Ambrette seed from Ecuador – on top of the 10 botanicals in standard Bombay Sapphire. The classic notes of juniper, angelica and coriander have been intensified but Ambrette is immediately apparent. Piquant spice, bergamot and ambrette seeds offer a twist by entwining themselves around the core juniper. It's an intense gin yet somehow retains the lightness expected of a Bombay distilled spirit.

### **Sword (40%)**

**£4.20**

Sword Gin is a divine potion harnessing a floral bouquet leaving subtle back notes of juniper clearly releasing your spirit. Enjoy this mystical gin.

### **Tann's, Spain (40%)**

**£3.20**

Tann's Gin is produced with 100% grain neutral spirit that combines the predominating taste of juniper berries, with a triple infusion of botanical ingredients that confer a special and refined touch to it. Its botanicals include; juniper berries, coriander, cucumber, cardamom, rose petals, lemon peel, mandarin peel, orange blossom, liquorice and raspberry.

### **Tanqueray, Export Strength (43.1%)**

**£3.20**

This gin has a really juniper-heavy experience. It is smooth, balanced and creamy without any harshness from the high alcohol content (not that surprising, being quadruple distilled). The coriander is present but subtle and the sweet earthiness of some of the botanicals holds it all together very well.

### **Tanqueray, No 10 (47.3%)**

**£4.20**

Tanqueray No.10 is handcrafted in small batches using their unique quadruple distillation process, with the heart of the gin created in the affectionately named 'Tiny Ten' still. Using fresh, whole citrus fruits during the process it greatly adds to the depth of character inherent in Tanqueray No. 10. Indisputably a step up in class, this gin is smoother than Tanqueray's classic offering. It has a full-bodied grapefruit and citrus hit to it. There's still plenty of juniper in the mix as well as a lovely floral note on the nose, but the smooth citrus finish and the relatively high strength is what makes this gin one of the very best on the market.

### **Tanqueray, Rangpur (41.3%)**

**£3.20**

Tanqueray has produced some of the finest gins for over 175 years and their London Dry Gin has become the benchmark for "real" gin. Rangpur is so called because of the Rangpur lime used to make it. The Rangpur lime is not like a normal lime; it has the expected zest of a lime but is as juicy as an orange and looks similar to a mandarin. This is not a lime flavoured gin where the gin is infused after distillation, the botanicals and flavourings are distilled into the spirit. This is a well-balanced gin with a real citrus twist.

### **Twisted Nose, Water Cress (40%)**

**£4.20**

This is a small batch craft gin, it combines 10 botanicals including Hampshire watercress and lavender to create a spirit that is intense, fragrant and very refreshing. The watercress adds sweet herbaceous notes and a peppery sparkle to the finish which complements the other carefully selected botanicals perfectly. The name comes from the word the Romans used for watercress, "Nasturtium", which means twisted nose.

### **The Botanist, Islay (46%)**

From the famous Whisky distillery on Islay, Bruichladdich, this is a true Scottish gin. Using 31 botanicals, of which 22 are hand-picked by a foraging team that scour the windswept hills, peat bogs and Atlantic shores of the Hebridean island, this really is a beautifully fragrant gin that delivers on all counts. Difford's 5 Star outstanding Rating

### **Thomas Dakin (42%)**

**£3.20**

To begin, juniper merges with horseradish in an unusual heady mix. Sweet orange and a sharper grapefruit join soon after, along with classic gin flavours of piney juniper, coriander seed and sweet liquorice. There's a distinct savoury finish along with a warming spice thanks to the cubebs. Thomas Dakin has a distinct flavour journey and a lot of personality that emerges at different stages, it's different whilst also being respectful of the fact that it is first and foremost, juniper centred.

### **Warner Edwards, Harrington Dry (40%)**

**£3.20**

Produced on Falls Farm in Northamptonshire by Warner Edwards, Harrington Dry is a delicious gin. It's based on barley spirit which is flavoured with 11 botanicals sourced from farms in Wales and England. These include juniper, elderflower and coriander. The taste is aromatic and spicy, with elderflower and lavender notes which lead into a palate of juniper, citrus and ginger.

### **Warner Edwards, Elderflower (40%)**

**£3.20**

The perfect summer tippie, it's sweet and floral on the pallet with a delicious viscosity that combines beautifully with the warm spices of the dry gin base. The Elderflower is used fresh and harvested once a year from the two farms in England and Wales that they own.

### **Whitley Neill (43%)**

**£3.20**

Whitley Neill includes two unique African botanicals; the fruit of the Baobab tree and Cape gooseberries. These very unique citrusy botanicals sit alongside 7 quite traditional gin botanicals - juniper, coriander, orange peel, lemon peel, Angelica root, cassia bark and orris root. The juniper is laid back to give the gin a little bit more warmth, there is slightly more coriander in the recipe which blends well with the citrus elements. The finish is slightly sweeter & very smooth, which hails from the orris root. There is also a touch of lemon peel on the end.

### **Whitley Neill, Quince (43%)**

**£3.20**

Blending Persian herbs with Turkish quince juice, Whitley Neill Quince Gin has prominent stone fruits (peaches and apricots) but is dominated by the unmistakable flavour of quince. Coriander and lemon zest make a notable appearance before ending with a long, fruity finish. This spirit has been inspired by the Greenall Whitley family's taste for adventure and discovery.

### **Whitley Neill, Rhubarb & Ginger (43%)**

**£3.20**

Whitley Neill's Rhubarb & Ginger Gin is a unique and flavoursome gin. The warming of the ginger doesn't overpower the lovely rhubarb taste. All together a perfect combination gin with a long, quality finish.

### **Whittaker's, Harrogate (42%)**

The Whittaker's set out to follow their passion for both the Yorkshire countryside and gin by producing an artisan gin from their home, Harewell House Farm, in the heart of Nidderdale in North Yorkshire. Their aim was to produce a small batch, handcrafted spirit which reflects the Yorkshire countryside in a bottle. It is a predominantly juniper based gin with coriander and angelica root. Bilberries bring a sharpness that compliments the juniper berries keeping the gin's character intact. Hawthorne berries bring a background sweetness. The addition of bog myrtle brings a spicy aroma with both bitter and balsamic flavours.

### **Will's (40%)**

**£5.00**

Designed for those who appreciate luxury and style, Will's Gin Premium was inspired by the goal of creating a perfect gin. It represents the desire and control that distillers exert in finding the perfect botanicals. Distilled five times, Will's takes a wide range of botanicals, fruits and spices to create a well-balanced gin with warming juniper, gentle spice and considerable citrus notes.

### **Xolato, Chocolate (40%)**

**£5.00**

The creators behind X Gin set out to revive the Aztec drink Xocolatl. Xocolatl was based on cocoa and was reserved exclusively for Kings and Queens. It was said to be a powerful aphrodisiac & obviously this sparked their interest! But rather than try and ferment chocolate, they instead set out to master a gin that used cocoa nibs as a key botanical. Elegant and refined, X Gin is a really innovative take on traditional gins. It has a dessert-like flavour with aromas of nuts, vanilla and cocoa. Every bottle is sold with a small container of cocoa nibs to garnish the drink

### **Xoriguer, Mahon (40%)**

**£3.20**

Xoriguer Gin (pronounced 'sho-ri-gair') is produced in Mahon, Menorca in Spain. A family run business, 60% of Xoriguer Gin stays in Menorca and 40% is exported. The gin is distilled using grape alcohol rather than the typical grain alcohol, and the botanicals remain a closely guarded family secret. Xoriguer Gin is a characterful gin that delivers excellent value gin for its price. The grapes in the base alcohol intentionally don't come through, but help give Xoriguer gin a distinct personality. It's floral and aromatic on the nose, with herbaceous and warm notes to taste.

### **Zymurgorium, Sweet Violet (18.7%)**

Zymurgorium, Sweet Violet has an incredible parma violet flavour with a good gin presence; it manages to avoid the tendency towards a syrup like viscosity that many gin liqueurs have. The sweet violets used to create this beautiful gin liqueur give it a sweet pastel flavour and provide a strong violet aroma.

### **Zymurgorium, Rhubarb & Cranberry (20%)**

**£4.20**

A fantastic cup based off an old family recipe with a lovely balance of tart & sweet botanical flavours and alcohol strength. The Rhubarb used is from their own land and is a constant competition winner year-after-year. The slight refreshing tart taste is perfect for adding to a Martini or other dry gin cocktails, add lemonade to make a quick Rhubarb variation of a Cosmopolitan.

### **Gosling's, Black Seal (40%)**

Black Seal has a rich, intricate flavour, well balanced and nuanced with butterscotch, vanilla and caramel.

### **Gosling's, Black Seal, 151 Proof (75.5%)**

**£4.20**

An overproof version of Gosling's iconic Black Seal rum, famous all over the world for having copyrighted the Dark 'N' Stormy cocktail.

### **Kraken (40%)**

**£3.20**

Plenty of nutty, vanilla and coffee aromas are deliciously supported by the spicy palate and a long, peppery finish.

### **Admiral Vernon's, Old J (35%)**

**£3.20**

Rich and sweet with a fair whack of vanilla in the mix.

### **Admiral Vernon's, Old J, Cherry (35%)**

**£3.20**

Still containing all the 11 flavours that go into the original Old J Spiced Rum but with an added infusion of marasca cherries.

At 13 years old this VSOP is already much older than legally required and there's no artificial colouring used as in some cognacs. A wonderful and elegant Cognac with pure class!

## ARMAGNAC

**Baron de Sigognac, 10 Year Old (40%)** **£4.20**

The 10 year old Baron de Sigognac delivers an exceptional and rare taste. Mild yet fiery at the same time like a gently toasted Arabica coffee. The aromas embody a wide range evoking floral followed by fruity notes yet overall dominated by the sensation of a perfect balance between fruit and spices.
