<p>This wine is very aromatic on the nose with notes of pineapple and apricot. 20 Gruner Veltliner, Scloss Gobelsburger, Loesstre - Austria	£25.00
<p>Gruner Veltliner is a serious grape, with aromas of white pepper and delicate spice. Don't think Germany, think dry and crisp, and a great food white!</p>

21	Mâcon Uchizy, Domaine Talmard, Burgundy - France Chardonnay from a father and son combination whose Domaine lies in the small town of Uchizy in the Maconnais. A pure and refreshing style, achieved by early picking of ripe grapes whilst they still have good levels of acidity and fermented using stainless steel only. Chardonnay without a cloak of oak.				£27.50
22	Sancerre, Domaine Dezat, Loire Valley - France Sauvignon Blanc from its classical spiritual home, the Loire Valley. Aromatic and vibrant – Sauvignon at its very best.			Bottle Magnum	£32.50 £65.00
23	Chablis, 1er Cru Les Vaillons, Domaine Billaud-Simon, Burgundy - France Domaine Billaud-Simon own some of the best Chablis Vineyards, in a number of 1er and Grand Cru sites.
